RA Training Learning Outcome #1 Resource Knowledge

List and describe important campus resources determining the multiple ways they may impact the position, and connect those resources with typical student/resident concerns and issues for possible referral.

RA Training Learning Outcome #2 Community Development

Discuss the importance of developing community, and apply the community development model to design effective and productive strategies for community development based on student population needs.

RA Training Learning Outcome #3 Student Accountability

Recognize behavioral concerns contrary to respectful, thriving living environments and actively identify and employ college and department protocols and procedures to resolve those concerns.

RA Training Learning Outcome #4 Helping Skills

Recognize the common characteristics of students in distress and create awareness of healthy practices for student success and personal well-being through role modeling and educational programming.
