Dear Members of the Curry College Community,

As you may be aware, effective December 26, 2020, Governor Baker rolled back on-site staffing occupancy levels to a maximum of 25% for office spaces. These office space capacity limits are in effect until 5:00 am on February 8, 2021 unless further extended by the Governor. While we are under this number, divisional heads will be communicating directly with employees regarding schedules.

As a reminder, students will be moving in beginning Wednesday, January 27. In order to accommodate for the traffic flow next week as students move-in, we recommend faculty and staff to utilize the back entrance to the College (Atherton Street entrance) between 7:30 am – 9:00 am and 4:30 pm – 6:00 pm. Commuters will also be coming to campus on Monday, Tuesday, and Saturday to complete their COVID-19 testing ahead of the first day of classes. <u>The following email</u> was sent to resident and commuter students last night detailing the move-in and check-in process.

Please remember that it is as important as ever that you continue to be vigilant about safety protocols, including mask-wearing, hand-washing, and social distancing as we move into the winter months ahead to continue keeping our Curry community safe.
