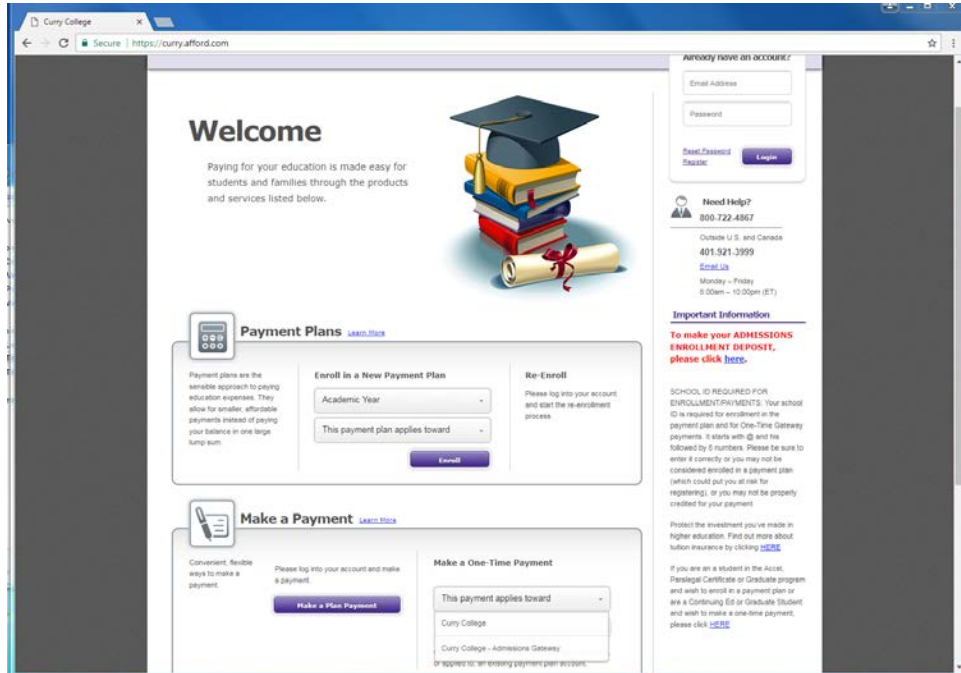
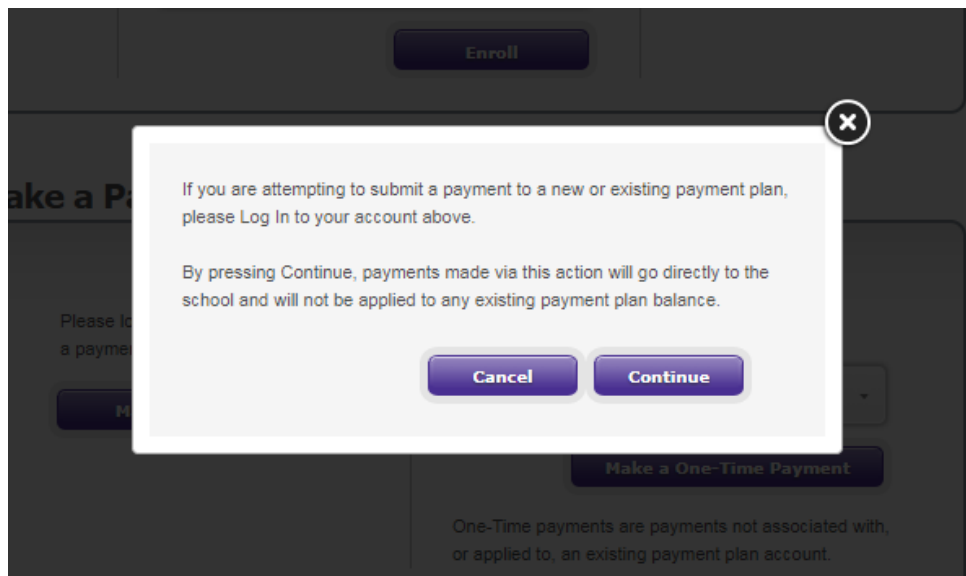


Adding Money to Student Printing
