The Fulbright program is the flagship international exchange program sponsored by the US Department of State, designed to increase understanding between people of the United States and other countries. Fulbright scholars are chosen for their academic merit and leadership potential. Scholars are provided with the opportunity to study, teach and conduct research abroad. The program operates in over 155 countries and awards approximately 7,500 grants annually. There are several Fulbright options with different deadlines. Opportunities for the Fulbright Core Program will be posted on the organization's website on February 1, 2012.
