# RISING LEADERS INITIATIVES

## STUDENT AND RECENT GRADUATE OPPORTUNITIES



### OVERVIEW

The USBLN's Rising Leaders Initiative is a career development program for students and recent graduates with disabilities through linkages with business professionals from USBLN corporate partners.

The Rising Leaders Initiative involves two programs: **The Mentoring Program** and the **Leadership Academy**.

The Mentoring Program is a six-month career mentoring opportunity to college students and recent graduates, including veterans, with disabilities. In 2017, there were 125 Rising Leaders in the Mentoring Program; many of whom were STEM-focused. **Approximately 85% of Rising Leaders have been employed since the program's inception.** Through the Mentoring Program, Rising Leaders benefit from a network of businesses connections.

The Founding Partners of the Mentoring Program are: Microsoft, Northrop Grumman and Deloitte.

The Leadership Academy is an intensive two-day networking and career development opportunity that takes place during the USBLN Annual Conference. **17 job offers were extended to USBLN Rising Leaders by the end of the Conference in 2017.**

The 2017 Leadership Academy was exclusively supported by Microsoft and Northrop Grumman.

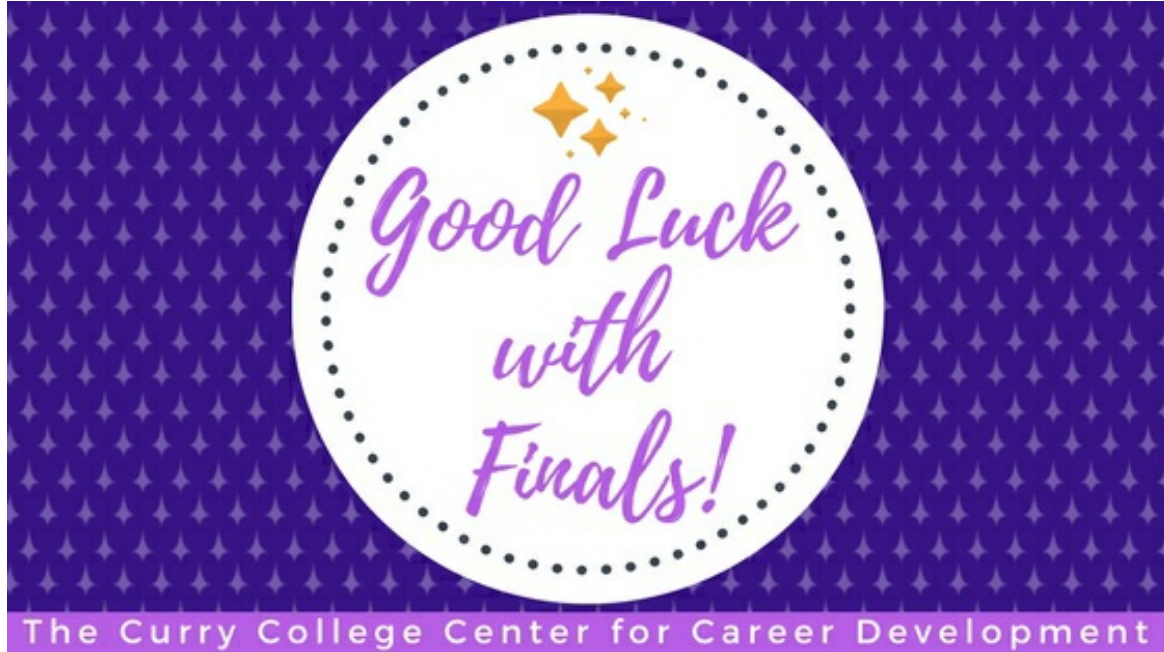
