

Once you have accessed Lynda.com through the Boston Public Library, you have access to thousands of tutorials that teach business, software, technology and creative skills.

To use Search, type in the name of the tutorial you are interested in; for example, Excel 2016. In this example, I am selecting Excel 2016 Essential Training:



- 4. Exercise Files download the exercise files that go along with the training


In this video, I have chosen "View Offline" and you can see the button to "Start the Download":
