### MFA for the Curry Fortinet VPN

Curry College will be enabling Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) for the Curry Fortinet VPN. If you have already enrolled in Curry MFA for your employee email, you will not have to perform any further MFA setup. **However, if you already have a VPN connection configured, you will have to modify your VPN connection to continue connecting.**

### Updating your VPN Connection Settings

Open your FortiClient VPN client.


Select your Curry VPN connection from the drop-down menu to the right of *VPN Name* (if you have multiple connections and it is not currently selected).



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### Configure a New VPN Connection

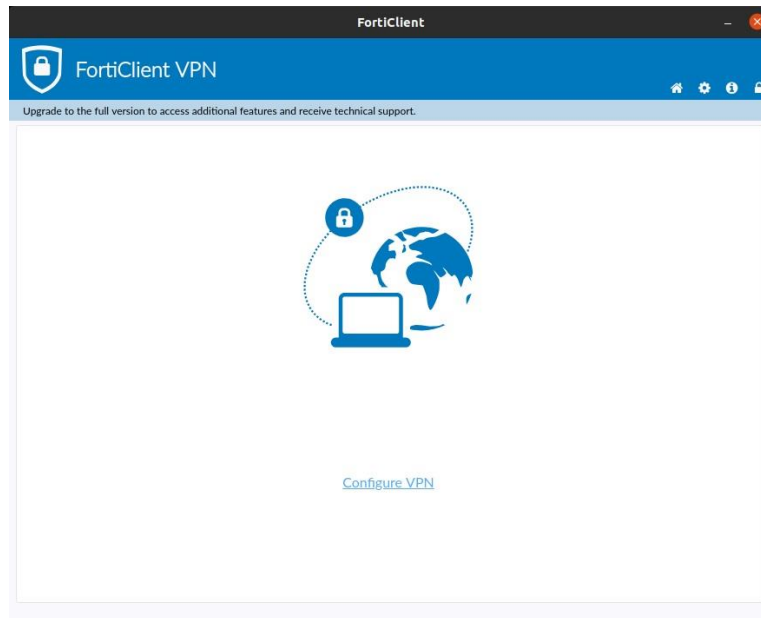
Navigate to the Fortinet website and download the FortiClient (FortiClient VPN only).

Install the FortiClient by running the executable you downloaded and follow the prompts.

Start the FortiClient by opening your *Start Menu*, selecting FortiClient VPN and opening the FortiClient VPN application.

The FortiClient application window should appear. Select *Configure VPN*.



Enter the following connection settings in the *New VPN Connection* window and select *Save*.


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### Connecting to the VPN


