- 10. Go back to the screen on step #7 and **Scan the QR code**. <u>Please **do not** scan the code on the instructions.</u> This will pair your phone app to your account.
- 11. Continue to the Let's try it out window on your computer, click Next



12. A notification will be sent to your mobile device via the Microsoft Authenticator app.

Once you receive the notification in the Microsoft Authenticator app, press Approve. This action is confirming that **you** initiated a login to your account
