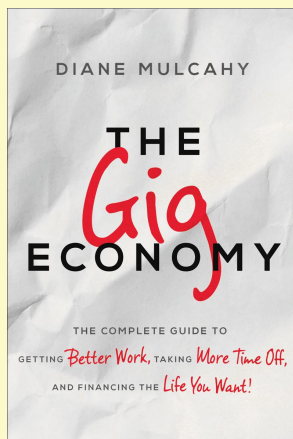

Speaker: Diane Mulcahy

Diane Mulcahy is the author of the book *The Gig Economy: The Complete Guide to Getting Better Work, Taking More Time Off, and Financing the Life You Want* (Amacom, November 2016).

Five years ago, Diane created and began teaching an MBA class on the Gig Economy at Babson College, where she is an Adjunct Lecturer. Diane writes and speaks frequently about the Gig Economy and is a regular contributor to *Harvard Business Review* on the topic. 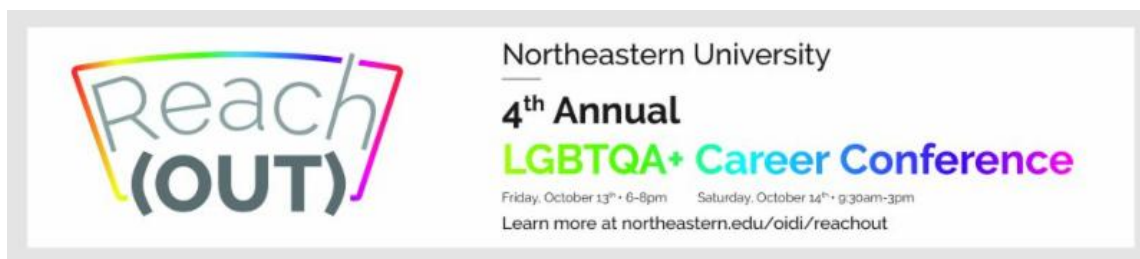
