Packages and Utilities: Import Package/View Logs - (Restore Course)

An Import package is a .ZIP file of exported Course content. Importing a package into an existing Course copies the content of the package into the existing Course, essentially you are Restoring your course.

Import packages do not include user enrollments or records, such as discussion board posts and assessment attempts.

Step 1: From the Control Panel under Packages and Utilities, click Import Package/View Logs.
