


*Why did you join your club/org?

 - * Announcement in class (when appropriate)



- * Approx. 30 seconds
- * Informative
- * Get interest from potential member
- * Answers:
 - * What is your organization?
 - * What do you do?
 - * What do members gain?



You've identified potential members, put up advertisements, and spoken with NM's now you have to get them there...

- * Contact NM's once you have their cell/e-mail
- * Remind them about events (i.e. meetings, programs)
- * Walk with them to the event...being new can be scary
- * Invite them to bring a friend

*Getting Them There

- * Make members feel welcome
- * Know why someone wants to be a part of the group
- * Give them purpose...
 - * Assign tasks based on STRENGTHS and INTERESTS
 - * Provide opportunities for input
- * Make praise public, authentic, and individualized
- * Be realistic with time requirements
- * Remember you are a role model
 - * Align your words and actions
 - * Find appropriate times and places to "vent"
 - * You = Standard for amt. and quality of work
- * Socialize outside of the group
